With this bread that we bring

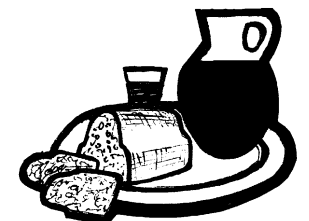
