## **Constructive criticism/suggestions**

Think about background noises.

The Zone services seem to miss the people they are targeting. There is too much which would make children lose interest e.g. 2 adult pieces together such as the Creed followed by the prayers. The talky bits are addressing adults not the children.

Some of the sound quality could be improved upon -

Music could be better

The use of recorded full congregational singing for any grand hymns. Musicians do not have to be seen.

More tuition on positioning in front of monitor Time coordination is poor on zoom

More songs - and for the children, actions to the words would help

Perhaps one or two of these services could be specifically child focused???

Make the sermons more 'animated' and normal. Difficult talking to an empty room - but that is what it often looks like.
