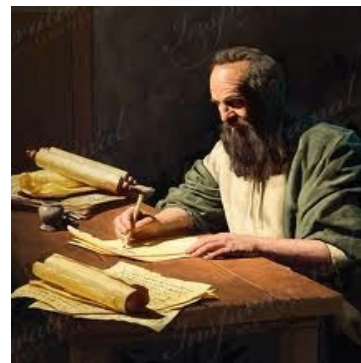


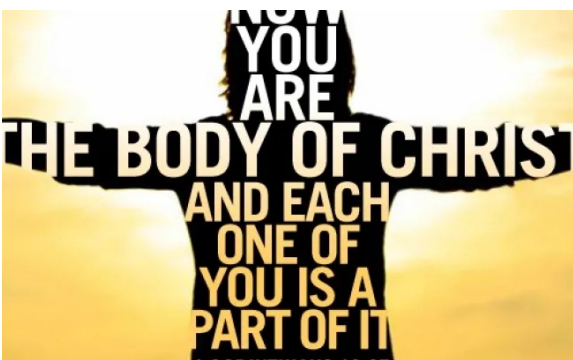
1 Corinthians 12 - Spiritual Gifts

The Apostle Paul was one of the most influential leaders of the early Christian Church. He played a crucial role in spreading the gospel during the first century, and his missionary journeys took him throughout the Roman empire.



Paul writes his letter to the Corinthians and tackles the issue of spiritual gifts in chapter 12 of his first letter to them. Paul insists that the display of spiritual gifts does not make one believer more spiritual or more important than another. Every believer in Jesus has the Holy Spirit, and the Holy Spirit gives to every believer one or more spiritual gifts.

Just as God gave us hands, feet, eyes, and ears to meet the needs of the whole body, He has given different people different gifts to meet the needs of the whole Church.

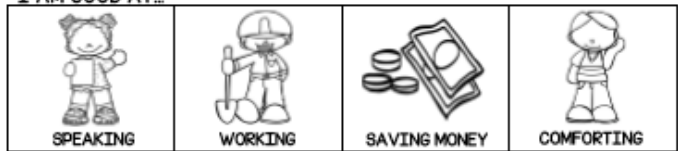

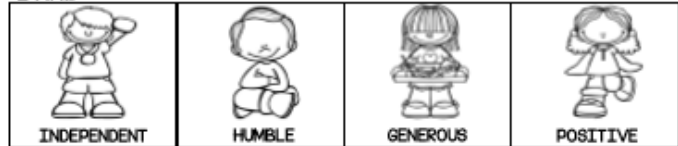
