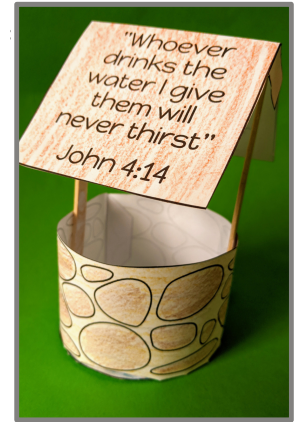

"You don't even have anything to get water in, how can you give me living water?" the woman asked.

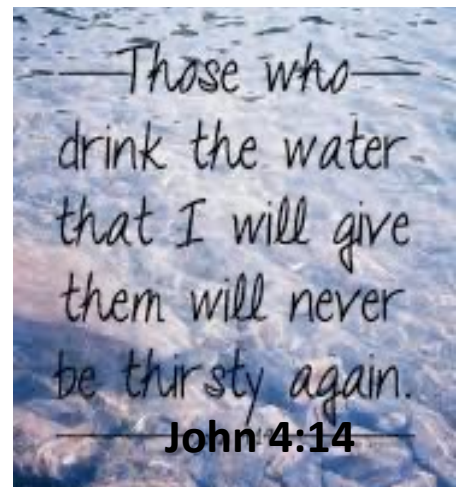
Then Jesus explained, "Whoever drinks from the water from this well will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst again."

The Gospel of John reminds us that Jesus comes to find and save all of us, and because of this, we have hope and we know that He loves each and every one of us.

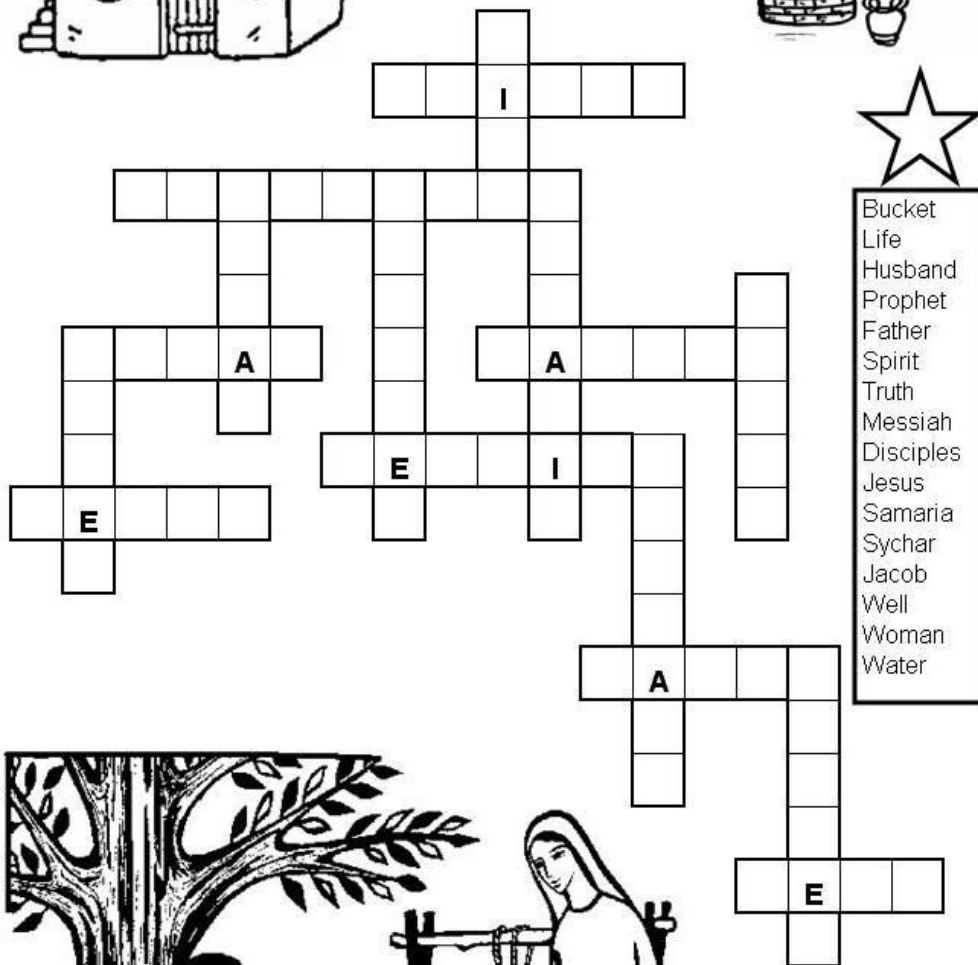

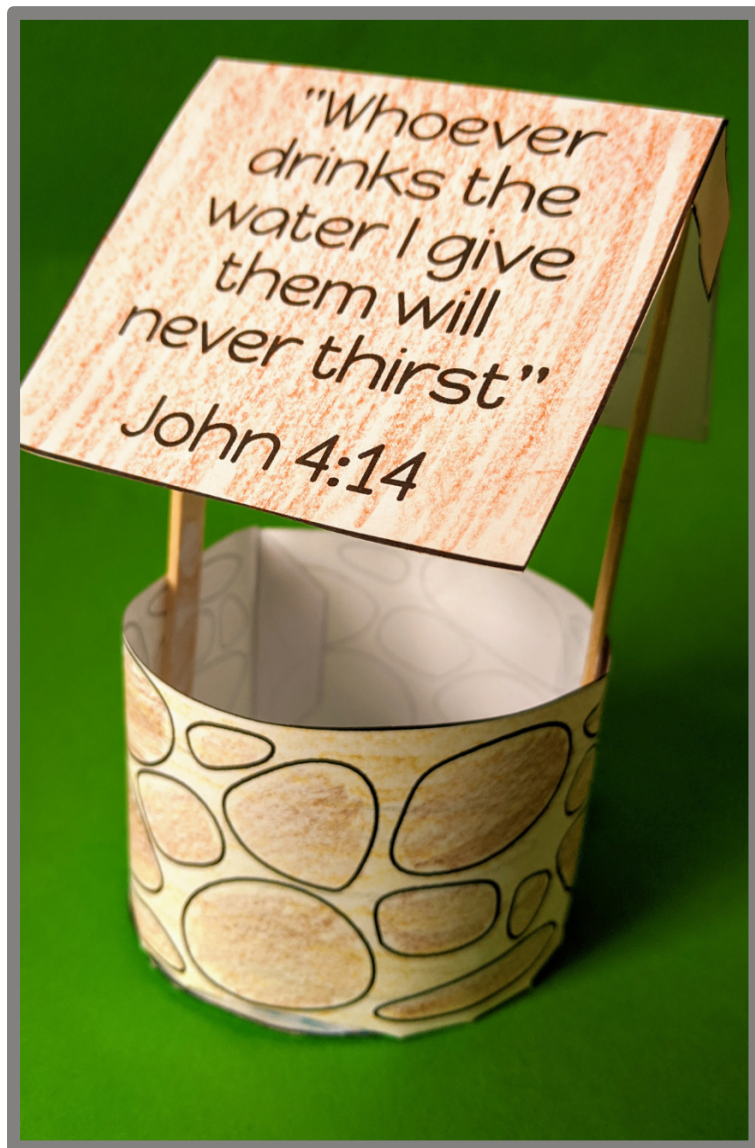


Make all the words fit into this crossword

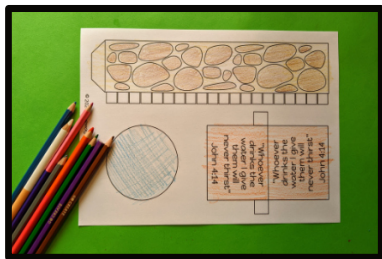
Jesus And The Samaritan Women – John 4

What to do:



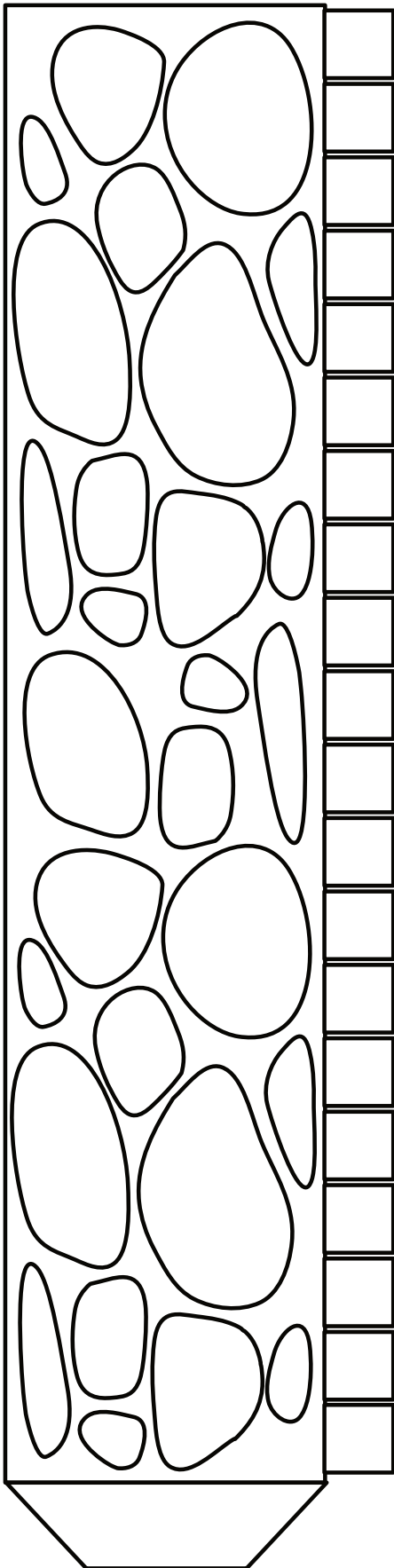
Colour the template page.
