### **Suggestions for our Praise and Prayers**

**Sun** Please ask God that we will become a more praying people and so ask God to deal with the Covid 19 epidemic quickly.

**Mon** Praise the Lord for a change in the law last week so that homeless victims of domestic abuse will be treated as a priority housing need by local authorities. Please pray for all who are homeless for any reason and for local authorities and housing associations endeavouring to find the solution for more housing.

**Tues** Pray for all in the hospitality sector, entertainment industry and the travel industry who will be preparing for the ending of lockdown restrictions. Pray also for those who remain very anxious that appropriate sensitivity may be shown.

**Wed** Nicci Maxwell our CMS Mission Partner in Uganda needs our prayers as she struggles with her hospital work dealing with very vulnerable babies and children and now they have the Coronavirus right across the country to manage and a total lockdown, including a curfew. Pray for Nicci's physical and emotional state.

**Thurs** Some Christian organisations estimate that a Christian is killed through persecution on average every two hours because of their faith in the Lord Jesus. Pray for our brothers and sisters living out their beliefs at risk to their lives. Pray for those Christians and others suffering long-term physical and mental trauma as a consequence of their treatment by ISIS over recent years.

**Fri** We remember in our prayers all those in our fellowship who are ill, awaiting a medical procedure or sick at home. All who are worried or face tensions in their home, praying the God of peace will meet them where they are.
