Responding to the changes in Covid regulations.

Several people have asked why we are continuing to ask people to wear a mask: We appreciate that there is no longer a mandate to do so, and that other churches may be more relaxed than we are, but as you will be aware in Torbay the level of infection is amongst the UK's highest, and we are urged by both government and our Church Leaders to continue to respect one another and be aware of the ongoing risks, knowing that even those of us vaccinated can still carry the virus.

This is why we continue to ask people:

- to sign in via the QR code on arrival
- > to respect each other's personal space and maintain 1-2m social distancing
- to wear a mask inside in order to protect others more than ourselves
- to refrain from embracing one another in the Peace
- to continue to use 'intinction' (dipping the wafer into the wine) during communion.

Offering Many people will be familiar with the Collection Plate being passed around in a Church service. Because of Covid (how many times has that phrase been used?!) we have not been passing a basket around, but instead have baskets at the back as well as a card reader which is near the entrance to the Link Corridor. If you are not signed up with the Parish Giving Scheme, nor have a standing order in place, and wish to contribute to the work of St Matthias, then please make use of either the basket or the card reader. Thank you.
