A New Church in the Bay! From the diocesan webpages...

The Church of England in Devon has been successful in its £1.5m funding bid for a new mission initiative aimed at young people and families in Torbay.

The new Bay Church will be based at St Andrew's Church in Paignton.

Rev'd Matt Bray, currently a curate at Harbour Church in Portsmouth, has been appointed as the church's leader. He said, "It feels very exciting and a very welcome answer to prayer! ...This funding gives us a great platform from which to join in with the incredible work already happening in the Bay...I can't wait to see the impact this will have on the lives of people in Torbay as we seek to play our part in seeing Jesus loved, the Church alive, and society transformed, in Jesus name!"
