Annual Church Meeting – The next Annual Church Meeting takes place in the church on Sunday 23rd May at 4.00 pm. Its purpose is to receive the Annual Report and the Financial Report for 2020 and to elect Churchwardens and PCC members. All are welcome to attend.
