RESTARTING THE ZONES

As we are slowly but surely coming out from the lockdowns and restrictions, we are very keen to try to get our ZONE families back together in the Church. On-line services have been a great blessing, and we are so grateful to have the technology available so that we have been able to keep in touch with each other, but we can't deny that it's not the real thing!

Some of us have been trying to work out the best way forward and – a bit like having VACCINE TRIALS last year – we are having a **ZONE TRIAL**.

We know that things will change, and we will have to continue to adapt what we are doing, but on **SUNDAY 9th MAY** we are going to be trying out a different format...

It doesn't have a name yet, but this is the plan:

- 9:30 Meet at church on the <u>Piazza AND at the same time the YouTube Premiere</u> showing. Together we have a couple of worship songs (these will be recorded for those watching on YouTube)
- 9:40 the YOUNG PEOPLE and CHILDREN go to the pre-school area with the leaders for activities, crafts and to learn about the Bible story while the ADULTS go into the main Church building to join with the on-line service which will be on the screens (or could go home for a short time)
- 10:10 the ADULTS go back outside to join back with the YOUNG PEOPLE and CHILDREN for a final song and a blessing.

Of course we understand that the timings may not be quite so accurate, but we are keen to be available both in person at the Church and on-line.

At the moment we are only able to have 15 children in any group, so <u>IF you KNOW you will be</u> joining us, please let us know so we can have an idea of numbers – but we hope you will come even if you aren't able to let us know beforehand. Phone 01803 311488 to book.

On SUNDAY 16th MAY we will be looking at the 'THY KINGDOM COME' material and this includes the CHEEKY PANDAS. The format will in part be dictated by how things go on the 9th and any feedback you might give us!
