## Readings

#### Romans 12:1-8

Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God – this is your true and proper worship. <sup>2</sup> Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is – his good, pleasing and perfect will. <sup>3</sup> For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you. <sup>4</sup> For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, <sup>5</sup> so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. <sup>6</sup> We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; <sup>7</sup> if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; <sup>8</sup> if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.

#### Mark 10:35-45

- <sup>35</sup> Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to him. 'Teacher,' they said, 'we want you to do for us whatever we ask.'
- <sup>36</sup> 'What do you want me to do for you?' he asked.
- <sup>37</sup> They replied, 'Let one of us sit at your right and the other at your left in your glory.'
- <sup>38</sup> 'You don't know what you are asking,' Jesus said. 'Can you drink the cup I drink or be baptised with the baptism I am baptised with?'
- <sup>39</sup> 'We can,' they answered.

Jesus said to them, 'You will drink the cup I drink and be baptised with the baptism I am baptised with, <sup>40</sup> but to sit at my right or left is not for me to grant. These places belong to those for whom they have been prepared.'

<sup>41</sup> When the ten heard about this, they became indignant with James and John. <sup>42</sup> Jesus called them together and said, 'You know that those who are regarded as rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. <sup>43</sup> Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, <sup>44</sup> and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. <sup>45</sup> For even

the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.'

### **Prover** Suggestions for our prayers and praise this week

**MON** Most people are back to work or their studies today. Pray that for Christians we know, that the "world of work" will be a place of achievement, fulfilment - and witness.

Our preferred method for regular giving is the Parish Giving Scheme

- It is very easy to sign up for this to commit a regular monthly amount to be taken automatically from your bank account.
- It is secure and easy to change if ever you need to.
- The scheme saves time for the treasurer & gives much better cash flow for the church because the Gift Aid claim is made directly.
- It also *invites* us each year to keep our giving in line with inflation.
