


## Readings for Today

#### 1 Corinthians 13: 1-7 NRSV

If I speak in the tongues of mortals and of angels, but do not have love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give away all my possessions, and if I hand over my body so that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing. Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

#### John 15: 9-17 NIVUK

<sup>9</sup> 'As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. <sup>10</sup> If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love. <sup>11</sup> I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. <sup>12</sup> My command is this: love each other as I have loved you. <sup>13</sup> Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. <sup>14</sup> You are my friends if you do what I command. <sup>15</sup> I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. <sup>16</sup> You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit – fruit that will last – and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. <sup>17</sup> This is my command: love each other.

#### **Suggestions for our Praise and Prayer**

**Sun** It would be lovely to see people around the Church praying for each other. Let's pray for the gift of prayer in our Church.

**Mon** Thank the Lord for the rain this week and pray for continued rain to restore water levels, and pray for better management of water supplies in this country.

**Tue** Pray for all who are ill, in hospital, or who are suffering as a result of the recent heat wave. Pray God will heal them.

**Wed** Pray for peace in our world, especially for the sad looking Ukraine. Pray that their grain will continue to be exported and bring relief in many parts of the world.
