

Annual Church Meeting – The next Annual Church Meeting takes place in the church on Sunday 23rd May at 4.00 pm. Its purpose is to receive the Annual Report and the Financial Report for 2020 and to elect Churchwardens and PCC members. All are welcome to attend. If you wish to vote though you need to be on the Church Electoral Roll. If you aren't on the electoral roll but live in the parish and attend (in person or online) and are over 16 you are entitled to apply. If you live outside the parish you need to have been 'attending' online or in person for at least 6 months. If St Matthias is *your church* you are encouraged to be on the electoral roll.
