Responding to the changes in Covid regulations.

Several people have asked why we are continuing to ask people to wear a mask: We appreciate that there is no longer a mandate to do so, but as you will be aware in Torbay the level of infection is amongst the UK's highest, and we are urged by both government and our Church Leaders to continue to respect one another and be aware of the ongoing risks, knowing that even those of us vaccinated can still carry the virus. This is why we continue to ask people:

- to sign in via the QR code on arrival
- to respect each other's personal space and maintain 1-2m social distancing
- to wear a mask inside in order to protect others more than ourselves
- to refrain from embracing one another in the Peace
- ➤ to continue to use 'intinction' (dipping the wafer into the wine) during communion.
